**Incentive to recycle**

Fraser Coast residents are taking to recycling with gusto. In response to requests from residents, the Fraser Coast Regional Council is now offering a second yellow top recycle bin to businesses and residents for \$60 a year. The standard waste bin service includes a weekly collection of one waste bin and a fortnightly collection of one yellow top recycle bin. Residents and businesses that take up the offer of a second bin should put the two yellow top bins out together once a fortnight on the same day that their rubbish is collected.

**Environment committee appointed**

Eight Fraser Coast residents have been appointed to the Fraser Coast Regional Council Environmental Advisory Committee. They are Darryl Stewart, Graham Berry, Merike Johnson, Shawn Wondunna-Foley, Carolyn Bussey, Ian Richards, James Hansen and Beni Giraspy.
